1. Which levers to raise - 3rd and 7th notes of the key your harp is tuned in. If no levers, then tune those notes to sharp.
2. Index Fingers Only plucking random notes
3. Index Fingers Only unison
4. Index Fingers Only echoed
5. Pentatonic Glisses
6. Blocked Thirds Unison
7. Blocked Thirds Echoed
8. Scale of Echoed Blocked Thirds
9. Rocked Thirds Upward

14. Grounding Chords (5th chord of the scale)

15. RH Four-note Run against LH 1-5-8
16. 1-5-8 Chord and Brushing Glisses
17. Sixths, blocked, unison, rocked, echoed
18. Octaves, blocked and Broken
19. Rolled 1-5-8's.
20. RH Recycles Against LH 1-5-8's
21. Chinese sounds
22. RH Cascade of Rocked Thirds Against LH 1-5-8
23. Whispering Glisses
24. Volume Variation.
25. RH Three-Note Runs against LH individual notes, ping-ponged.
26. LH 1-5-8's Against RH Pebbles Falling Glisses
27. RH Scales against LH 1-5-8's
28. Metallic Sounds by plucking with fingernails near soundboard
29. Metallic RH against LH normal 1-5-8's or Triads
30. Four Note Chords, unison.
31. Four Note Chords, echoed.
32. Four Note Chords, played Contrary Motion. Slow or fast.
33. Triads Contrary Motion
34. Triads Echoed
35. Triads Contrary Motion
